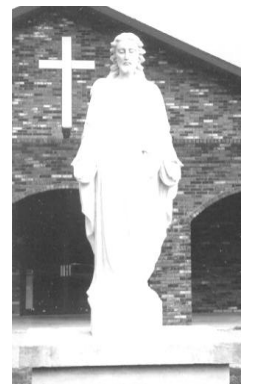

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

My column last week reintroduced the pious devotion of Adoration and Benediction for the five Fridays of Lent. This week I want to offer a couple more opportunities to deepen our Lenten journey. The first is a reminder of the Lenten disciplines of fasting and sacrifice. We observe the fast from meat on all Fridays of Lent. People are encouraged to “give up” something during Lent. I remember when I was in grade school we gave up homework for Lent, Sister Teresita didn’t buy it. The Lenten sacrifice should be something we would truly miss for fifty days. Here I want to introduce an old Benedictine practice, the Bona Opera that translates good work. I encourage you to think of a charitable act to offer, even write it down. There will be a basket in the back of church to leave them. I promise I am not going to look at them. Last, I will be offering a Lenten Bible study of St. Paul’s Letter to the Philippians. We will start with a pitch in after the 11:00 a.m. Mass at Our Lady. We will gather in Macke Hall, eat and then my presentation and discussion. We will do this for the five Sundays of Lent, please come together for fellowship and study. Blessed Lent to all.
