Father Peter's Column

Welcome to Lent. Let's spend some time reflecting on the readings of Lent. There is a two-fold theme to the Lenten Sunday readings. We begin with the first part which runs from Ash Wednesday through the Saturday of week three. The theme is a call to a life of conversion. The readings generally speak about beginning anew, of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving; of conversion; of mutual forgiveness; of hardness of heart; of love of enemies; and of the call to holiness.

The readings of the second half of Lent are taken from the Gospel of St. John, heard as a presentation of the mystery of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, of whom John says that all who believe in Him will have eternal life.

I will be adding times for confession starting Monday, March 11. Both here and at Christ the King I will be available for a half hour or more, if necessary after the 8:30 Mass and a half hour before the 4:30 at Our Lady and the 4:00 at Christ the King. I will be extending Saturday time to start at 3:30 until 4:30. If this doesn't fit in your schedule, stop and ask me and we'll find a time. Blessed Lent.
